The Stewart Centre @ EIT has two contracts with ACC:-

Supported Activities Service. This service is for clients with moderate to severe brain injury who need support to maintain their level of independence.

Supported Living Service where the Stewart Centre @ EIT is contracted to provide one to one support for people in the community.
